Expectations:

Algebra Binders:

- ✎ Just for ALGEBRA
- ✎ Neat and organized
- ✎ These will be checked each test day and you will be given a grade for your notes/binder.

Notes:

Notes will be taken in class almost every day. It is important for you to take good notes and to keep them organized in your binder.

Your notes will help you with homework, studying for quizzes and tests, and will be graded at the end of each unit.

Homework:

Homework will be assigned nearly every day. Problems selected for homework will allow you to practice what was discussed in class in addition to giving you an idea of what to expect on a quiz or a test. Putting 100% effort into these assignments will be your key to success in this class.

- ✎ NOTE: It is an expectation that IF you are given time to work on homework in class, *you do so*.
- ✎ All homework assignments are due at the BEGINNING of class the following day unless otherwise noted.




Most homework assignments will be graded out of 10 points.

- ✎ To earn ANY points: your homework must include your name and ALL of YOUR OWN work!
- ✎ A 10 point homework assignment demonstrates an honest attempt at every problem with all work shown.

Make-Up Policies:

-  **Notes:** If you are absent, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to get notes from a classmate or take notes from the presentation online.
-  **Homework:** It is also your responsibility to ask a *classmate or me*, check the *calendar* and/or *homework folder* for missed assignments. You have one day for each day absent for make up.
-  **Quiz/Test:** If you are absent on the day of a quiz or test, you will be expected to *make up the quiz or test on the day you return*, either at lunch or after school. See me to set up a time.

Passes:

At the beginning of each quarter, you will be given ONE punch card that is good for ONE “forgotten” homework assignment and THREE restroom/locker visits. You must have the card present at the time you plan to use it. If you lose the punch card, it will not be replaced! Any unused passes will be extra credit at the end of the marking period.

-  **Homework Pass (1):** will give you full credit (10 points) for a forgotten or incomplete homework assignment.
-  **Restroom Passes (3):** please try to use at a time that minimizes any class disruption.
